

## Site Pricing - 2005

### The Problems:

1. The current site pricing file can store just 10 prices: current, and the 9 previous prices. This fills up fast when one change prices every day, or multiple times per day. Some have even lost the applicable price before they could download the transactions. It also provides no audit trail of what your site pricing was at some point in the past.
2. The maintenance of site pricing was cumbersome manual task, wading through site after site, pump after pump, entering the same effective date and time over and over. This was a real time-waster.
3. Despite all this effort, there was no one-stop place in which to view ALL the current pricing at your domestic sites. One could only ramble through the site screens, one at a time, to see what the current prices are.

### The Solution:

- We've reworked Cardlock Site pricing in a number of ways.
  - We store unlimited prices, going back as far as you want to retain the data --- years if you want. This is fully integrated into the Cardlock pricing process.
  - We added a rapid-entry module to reduce the rote task of updating pricing to the fewest keystrokes possible.
  - We've made it easier to edit prior pricing. Previously, one needed to juggle entries that were "1<sup>st</sup> Prior", 3<sup>rd</sup> Prior" and so forth, manually moving them around as needed. Now we can just pick an item and edit it.
- We allow you to define the site/pumps that "matter" to you and give you both a quick report and a screen view to show an overview of current prices. These are presumably your domestic sites, but needn't always be.
- We've improved the Site Price Report to just show current prices, or prices after a date. And, of course, we can now show prices from far into the past, if needed.

Cost for this upgrade: 5 hours, which includes assistance in defining "your" site/pumps, the ones you want to step through for rapid-entry, and the ones you want to see in the "snapshots" as shown on the next page.
